#### AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT; CHANGING THE NAME OF RED ROCK CHAPTER TO TSE ŁICHÍÍ'CHAPTER; AMENDING 11 N.N.C. § 10

#### BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Enactment of the Change of Name from Red Rock Chapter to Tsè Łichíí' Chapter Act

The Navajo Nation hereby approves the Change of Name from Red Rock Chapter to Tsè Łichíí' Chapter Act.

#### Section 2. Amendments to Title 11 of the Navajo Nation Code

The Navajo Nation hereby amended the Navajo Nation Code, Title 11, § 10, as follows:

#### § 10. Election precincts; polling places; delegates

A. The election precincts, polling places, and delegates for each election community are designated as follows:

#### Section 3. Codification

The provisions of this Act which delete or amend sections of the Navajo Nation Code shall be codified by the Office of Legislative Counsel. The Office of Legislative Counsel shall incorporate such provisions in the next codification of the Navajo Nation Code.

#### Section 4. Savings Clause

If any provision of this Act is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the portions of this Act which are not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

- The Red Rock Chapter is a chapter of the Navajo Nation Government pursuant to Navajo Tribal Council Title II, Chapter 9, Section 4001(a) and (d) through which the chapter is granted governmental authority to promote and protect the interest and general welfare of its community people; and
- 2. Red Rock Chapter was recognized as a chapter in 1976 and is a unit of local government which are political subdivisions of the Navajo Nation; and the chapter maintains activities on behalf of the community membership; and
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 1, subchapter 1, section 131 (1)(2), of the same "Act (Title 26), the Red Rock Chapter has the responsibility and authority to promote, protect and preserve the interest and general welfare including the safety of its community, people, programs, property, etc.; and
- To further promote, protect and preserve the interest and general welfare including the safety
  of its community, the Red Rock Chapter wishes to change the English name to the Navajo name
  of Tse Lichii; and
- 5. During emergency situations, providers tend to confuse the community with Red Rock State Park and emergency provid
